



Peisey-Vallandry is made up of a collection of small satellite villages in France, which form the larger Les Arcs ski area. Peisey-Vallandry offers a relaxed atmosphere that is best suited to families and groups looking for a calmer resort. In the villages there are a selection of bars, restaurants, and shops to peruse off the slopes. The old village of Peisey is a charming and traditional destination with plenty of character. The ski terrain is best suited to intermediate skiers, with more than 170km to explore. It is an excellent choice for exploring the whole Paradiski ski region.

Top Runs

- From Vallandry 1600m take the bubble lift to the top and enjoy several cruisy blue runs either returning to the village or on to Arc 1800.
- For a more challenging slope, take the Peisey 61 and ski down Combe red run, it has excellent off-piste opportunities to practice your skills.
- For an unforgettable glacier run, make your way over to the east side of Les Arcs and take the Aiguille Rouge 30 bubble to the highest peak. There you will find a tough black run, taking you down to Arc 1950.



Best for Après Ski

- **Bar Mont Blanc**
A lively bar to visit after a day's skiing. Dance on the sundeck to the live music or visit after dinner for a comedy performance. Enjoy Sky Sports or get competitive over a game of pool.
- **Mojo Bar**
Another great evening spot and conveniently located by the Vallandry lift. Enjoy a snack or two with a well-earned beer. Take advantage of the happy hour offers!
- **La Folie Douce (Les Arcs)**
Visit the infamous bar for the ultimate après experience. Dance on tables, listen to DJ sets and be impressed by the spectacular performances. Whether it be family, friends, young or old, it is a great bar for a fun-filled afternoon.
